

Closing date for reserved entries will be March 10, 2023.

Walk-ins will ONLY be accepted 1 hour prior to the squad time and a \$5.00 fee will be assessed to late entries.

Tournament Rules and Entry Form

- 1. All entrants must have a current USBC card in the state of Nevada for the 2022-2023 season.
- 2. Handicap will be 90% of 220 of the individual average in each division except optional scratch singles (additional cost).
- 3. Entrants shall use their highest USBC league average for the 2022-2023 season minimum of nine (9) games, as of February 1st, 2023. If a player does not have a current average with 9 games, they will use their 2021-2022 book average. If a bowler does not have either the above averages, they will bowl scratch (220). All bowlers and coaches are responsible for submitting league sheets from all the leagues they participated in for the 2022-2023 season. If incorrect averages are submitted, bowlers will be re-rated with the correct average and placed in the correct division.
- 4. All entries submitted must have a verifiable average attached. Average verifications must have the bowlers name, average, and number of games bowled. (A copy of the most current or final league standing sheet, as of February 1st, 2023).
- 5. Bowlers are not limited to the number of times they may enter the Team event, providing there are no more than two (2) of the same bowlers on a new team. **THE FIRST TEAM EVENT SERIES IS TO BE COUNTED IN ALL EVENTS**. Pacers will not be allowed. Team event in all Divisions may consist of four (4) boys, four (4) girls or any combination of four (4) boys or girls.
- 6. A bowler may enter the Doubles/Singles event more than once, However IF YOU ENTER DOUBLES, THE FIRST TIME YOU MUST ALSO BOWL SINGLES. The first Doubles and Singles bowled will be used for All Events. If you enter subsequent Doubles, you must bowl with a different person for each Doubles entered. Bowlers may enter Doubles with someone from other than their own Division. Doubles will be bowled first. Doubles in all Divisions may consist of two (2) boys, two (2) girls or mixed. If one bowler is late for the Doubles event, the entrant present will bowl Singles first. If their partner has not arrived by the time the Singles games are complete, and a substitute is not available, they will be permitted to bowl their Doubles games in order to qualify for all events. Bowlers are allowed to enter singles more than once.
- 7. All Events is a separate Event and will cost \$3.00. If you wish to enter All Events, you must mark the proper spot on the entry form and pay the fee.
- 8. Scratch Singles is an additional separate side-pot and will cost \$5.00. If you wish to enter Scratch Singles, you must mark the proper spot on the entry form and pay the fee.
- 9. Suitable attire must be worn. Bowlers should wear collared or bowling style shirts. Skorts and skirts should be no more than 2 (two) inches above the top of the knee. No tank tops, spandex, sagging pants, fleece, no clothing depicting obscene language, gestures, HOLES, alcohol or tobacco products (including e-cigs) will be allowed. No head gear of any kind will be allowed. No electronic devices of any kind (cell phones, iPads, etc.) are allowed. Final determination of proper attire will be at the discretion of the Tournament Director or their designee(s). Bowlers should be dressed in Tournament attire at Check-in and must present themselves, (not parents,) at check-in for this purpose.
- 10. The use of alcohol, tobacco or electronic cigarettes by spectators during the tournament will not be permitted, except in areas designated by the Bowling Center.
- 11. A bowler may be suspended from the Tournament for using tobacco products, electronic cigarettes, alcoholic beverages, using foul language or gestures or for any inappropriate behavior. Adults may not consume alcoholic beverages behind any lanes that Youth bowlers are competing on.
- 12. **Tardy Bowlers:** Bowlers arriving late will receive no score for any missed frames if not replaced by a substitute. Once a substitute has thrown a ball for score, he/she will complete the event.

- 12. Check in time is one hour before the below listed squad times.
- 13. Bowlers must remain in the settee area during competition. Permission to leave the area must be given by a Lane Monitor or a Tournament official. Food and Beverages will be allowed but must be kept in the area behind the bowler's lane.
- 14. Teams will bowl in the order listed on the entry. Entries will be given schedule preference based on the distance traveled and the order received.
- 15. **Divisions:** The number of entries will determine the number of Divisions. Singles and All Events will have Divisions for both Boys and Girls. The final Division Breakdown will be determined after all entries have been received, in order to try and make them as equal in numbers and averages, as possible.
- 16. Results will be posted within 30 days after completion of the Tournament. Until then, all results are considered unofficial.
- 17. **Scholarships:** Scholarships will be awarded on a minimum of a 1 in 3 ratio of entries in a division not to exceed 5 places per division. The tournament Committee will determine the scholarship amounts based on receipts and donations. All Scholarships will be forwarded to the SMART program, account #11709, at the National SMART office. Scholarship winners will be contacted by SMART concerning the use and redemption of any scholarships earned.
- 18. Any rules not set forth in this Entry Form will be covered by General USBC Playing Rules.
- 19. Any appeals or protests regarding scores or eligibility must be made in writing to the Tournament director within 24 hours of the time the infraction or error occurred. The decision of the Committee will be final, except when an appeal has been made in writing within 72 hours to the State Youth Committee.
