Mixed doubles format: The Mixed Doubles Tournament is a handicap **virtual** tournament. Each team shall consist of two senior members (age does not matter) – **ONE MALE AND ONE FEMALE** who are members of the Nevada State USBCA. You may bowl with as many partners as you wish **on the same squad**. This event will use the scores from your first 3 singles games for your team total. This will allow you to bowl with more people without having to bowl as many games. The mixed doubles will be limited to one PBA card member per team. PBA members must not be in exempt status to compete. The combined scores plus handicap shall determine the Mixed Doubles tournament winners. You can only bowl with the same doubles partner once.

TOURNAMENT RULES

1. All senior male and female members over the age of 50 on or before October 2, 2026, who belong to any USBC bowling association in the State of Nevada are eligible to enter. No out of state bowlers are allowed to bowl unless they are already bowling in a sanctioned league in Nevada and have paid their national, local, and state dues in Nevada (and can show proof of membership).
2. Entry fee is \$60.00 per person for the tournaments. You can also bowl doubles during your singles games as a virtual event. You may bowl with more than one person on the same squad for your double's entry. Any savings on lineage will go back into the prize fund for larger payouts for the tournament. Entry fee is \$20.00 per person for the Mixed Doubles for a total of \$40.00 per team. Entry forms must be filled out in detail and must match your membership card. NO NICKNAMES PLEASE. You may add bowling partners to your doubles entry at the time you check in.
3. No multiple entries are permitted in the NSUSBCA Senior Championship. The Single's tournament format will consist of bowling 6 games. The bowler must bowl in **two** 3 game squads. The total score of the 6 games will determine the winner of each division. PBA members who are not in exempt status will be allowed to compete. **The Mixed Doubles Tournament is a handicap virtual tournament. Each team shall consist of two senior members (age does not matter) – ONE MALE AND ONE FEMALE who are members of the Nevada State USBCA. You may bowl with as many partners as you wish on the same squad (you can only bowl with the same doubles partner once).** This event will use the scores from your singles games. This will allow you to bowl with more people without having to bowl as many games. The Mixed doubles will be limited to one PBA card member per team. PBA members must not be in exempt status to compete. Your scores from your three-game singles series will be used. The combined scores plus handicap shall determine the tournament winners. You may enter the mixed doubles as many times you wish (with different partners on the same squad).
 - a. ****Closing Date for entries is October 2, 2026, for the 1st weekend and October 9th for the 2nd weekend. On-site registration will be allowed if space is available. ****
 - b. ****Payment is due with your entry form when reserving your squad time. ****
4. **No refunds of entry fees after the entry has been accepted and scheduled. Unless the tournament is canceled.**
5. Handicap is 90% of 225 for all bowlers
6. AVERAGE USAGE and requirements are as follows:
 - a. Entrants will use their composite average of all 2025/2026 leagues of 21 or more games. All Sport League and Challenge League averages will be converted using the USBC Average Conversion Chart for the purpose of determining the bowler's composite average. Tournament managers reserve the right to adjust a bowler's average to a tournament average based on past local tournaments, state tournaments, national open tournaments.
 - b. An individual without a qualifying average under section A will use the highest current league average based on a minimum of 21 games (2025-2026 season) as of the tournament starting date (October 9, 2026). Sport League and Challenge League averages will be converted using the USBC Average Conversion Chart in determining the highest 2025-2026 average. (Must provide verification (league sheet) at time of bowling.)
 - c. USBC Rule 319a2 does apply.
 - d. USBC Rule 319a3 will apply. Please ensure your average is correct in accordance with this rule regarding submitting proper average and correction of averages. This will include using USBC Conversion averages for Sport shot, tough shot, challenge shots or leagues that change patterns throughout the season.
 - e. USBC Rule 319d will apply. Bowlers who have qualified for a prize of \$600.00 or more in any tournament within the previous 12 months must report actual scores, position, and amount won for possible average adjustment.
 - f. USBC Rule 319e will apply. A bowler MUST report a 10-pin tournament average increase before bowling for possible average adjustment.
7. The winner of each division (does not include the Mixed Doubles Tournament) will receive a paid entry into the National Seniors Tournament on August 3–6, 2027 (will be held at the Stardust Bowl in Addison, IL) if they choose to compete. If the winner does not compete, the second-place winner in the division will be eligible. If neither the first nor second place of a division wishes to compete, no entry will be issued. Those that compete in the senior championship to win your spot will receive a USBC Senior Championship Jersey if you choose to go to the National Tournament in August 2027.
8. All other USBC rules not covered in this form will apply and will be strictly enforced.
9. In the case of ties for first place Co-Champions will be declared as stated in USBC Rule 326 a, but the highest three game handicapped series will determine who will receive the paid entry into the National Seniors Tournament.
